

Fort Cavazos, Texas is not just another posting but an active, devoted community with vast offerings where newcomers quickly feel right at home. Fort Cavazos Quick Facts:

- Fort Cavazos spans nearly 215,000 acres of land in the heart of central Texas
- It is conveniently located halfway between Waco and Austin
- Fort Cavazos is the most populous US Military Installation in the world with over 45,000 soldiers and active-duty military personnel, 10,000 civilians and employees, 19,000 family members living on base and about 90,000 family members living off base
- The land was founded in 1942 and originally used to train troops and test World War II tank destroyers

About Fort Cavazos

They say everything is bigger in Texas and Fort Cavazos is no exception. Your new posting is one of the largest and most populated military installations in the world and is the largest armored post in the U.S. Armed Forces, making it the premier installation to train and deploy heavy forces. Fort Cavazos is the location of the III Corps headquarters and The First Army Division West headquarters as well as the 1st Cavalry Division, 13th Sustainment Command, First Army Division West, 3rd Cavalry Regiment, 1st Medical Brigade and many other Forces Command units.

Surrounding Cities and Major Destinations

Fort Cavazos is conveniently located at the center of what's known as the "Texas Triangle" - the metropolitan hub between Dallas, Houston and San Antonio - in the heart of one of the fastest growing areas in the country.



Fort Cavazos Attractions & Amenities






Things to Consider
